

Accessibility info

The vogue classes are held in HAM, third floor exhibition space. Currently there is a *Dance! Movement in the Visual Arts 1880–2020* exhibition ongoing. There's an elevator in the building with which you'll access all the floors. While the museum is closed for general public, we will go through the art workshop space on second floor and continue to the third floor. At the main entrance (Eteläinen Rautatiekatu 8) and at the back door of the art workshop space there are doorsteps of few centimeters. The width of all the doors is accessible with a wheelchair. The accessible toilet is on the second floor, at the backdoor of the art workshop space, on the same floor as the ticket counter. You'll need a code from the staff to open the door. On the second floor there are toilets divided by gender and on the third-floor office there are gender neutral toilets.

The documentary screening and lecture are in HAM corner which is right next to the main entrance of the museum (Eteläinen Rautatiekatu 8). There are big, black and yellow window tapes outside the space. On the main entrance there is a few centimeters doorstep and the main doors are heavy to open. Ask the museum staff for assistance, if necessary. HAM corner has its own entrance door in the downstairs lobby. All participants are provided with a chair and the space can be modified based on specific needs.
